BOOK BUYBACK

To maintain low book prices, the Rocker Shop encourages students to bring their unwanted textbooks back to the bookstore during finals week for cash on the spot! Value of each title is based on supply and demand as well as condition.

RENT TEXTBOOKS

The Rocker Shop also offers a textbook rental program to give students a lower-priced alternative to purchasing textbooks.

Textbook Rental Program

- A credit card is required to secure the rental.
- A different form of payment may be used to complete the transaction.
- Credit card will be charged only if rental is not returned by the end of rental period

Return

- Unacceptable damage includes:
 - Cover or pages torn or missing
 - Excessive highlighting or writing on pages
 - Any water damage
 - Missing components
- Textbook rentals not returned by end of rental period will be charged per rental agreement

DIGITAL TEXTBOOKS

The Rocker Shop provides simple and affordable access to digital textbooks on select titles. Digital textbooks offer additional functions and are available on most web-based devices. Digital course materials DO NOT include access codes.

FIRST DAY ACCESS

Program is selected by the instructors and available on select titles. Students are able to access course material through D2L on or before the first day of class. The charge is conveniently billed to their student account. If students choose to opt out, they can do so before the University's Add/Drop deadline. Inclusive Access is a more convenient and less expensive option for students.
